Drinks will be provided. Please bring your family too!



Dear Loving and Affectionate Rev. Father in Crucified Christ,

Greetings of love, peace and joy! From your spiritual brother in Christ Jesus, Fr. Jacob Prasad Pulapaka, Parish Priest of Kuchipudi.

Let me introduce myself to you. I am Fr. Jacob Prasad Pulapaka, (I met you on Facebook) I am a young Catholic Priest, Ordained on April 20th in the year 2006. In the beginning I rendered my humble services to PIME Society for 3 years, then I was appointed as first parish priest of the newly erected Muchintala Mission, later on in Velagalagudem Parish, Presently I am appointed as Parish Priest of Kuchipudi.

I am in a remote parish where many of the Catholics are "extremely poor and belong to the most vulnerable communities in India (Dalit and Tribal communities)". All of them are landless labourers and live on daily wage work for survival. Hardly, they earn One and a half Dollars (\$1.5) if only they go for work. This is the reality of the most abandoned people. I would like to do something for the development of these marginalized communities especially for the education of their children along with priestly ministry. Though these people are poor, Illiterate but they are highly devoted, God fearing and are faithful to their practices of Catholic faith. They are regular for all the Church activities and very much dependent on the providence of God.

Many children, old men and women even today, live in unhygienic conditions. They are very much primitive in their culture and tradition. Since they belong to the bottom rung of the financial and social ladder, their children cannot afford to go for further studies to attain better prospects. Many youths (both boys and girls) are unemployed. Due to lack of education and proper catechesis, the people really live under pathetic conditions. We need to empower all the people. As a priest, I took a commitment i.e. "Preferential Option for the poorest of the poor." So, my heart always goes for them.

In view of all these realities, I very much require your genuine help and support for my priestly ministry to bring Glory to God. I earnestly appeal to you, with folded hands to help me as much as you can and whatever the possible way you would like to...

I am direly in need your genuine help, may be in the form of little financial assistance, Few Mass stipends, Lenten alms. Little financial assistance for the most vulnerable children for their education for buying study material educational supplies, Mass Vestments, Mass kit, Holy Rosaries, Miraculous Medals, Brown Scapulars, Medals of various saints, Cords, Book Markers, Religious pictures and Religious Articles and few addresses of few generous people. Whatever is feasible; kindly extend your helping hands to continue the mission of Jesus among the poorest of the poor. I shall be immensely grateful to you for your magnanimity.

Assuring you of my sincere prayers and God's Choicest Blessings for all your family members, friends, near and dear ones. I remain under your fraternal/maternal Guidance.
